



Reserva del Señor

Tequila Añejo 100 % Agave

An impressive añejo given a lot of flavours from the barrel; vanilla, butterscotch, caramel and chocolate to name a few. Suitable as an aperitif in a Riedel tequila glass and/or accompanied by some sweet, dark chocolate. Received silver medal at The Beverage Testing Institute 2004 "Highly recommended". Reserva del Señor is also available as Blanco and Reposado.

Character

Amber. Obvious traces of vanilla and some butterscotch. Fruity, but with some of character of the agave. Opens softly with butterscotch, passes into vanilla and caramel, with a long finish of oak, pepper, caramel and milk chocolate. An impressive añejo where the flavours from the barrel are pleasantly evident.

Manufacturing

Tequilas del Señor's agave fields are located in Los Altos, but the distillery is placed in the outskirts of Guadalajara next to the beautiful colonial paths of Tlaquepaque. The agave is cooked in an autoclavé, which extracts aromas from the raw agave plant. Reserva del Señor is twice distilled in pot stills made of stainless steel and then aged in whiskey barrels.

Distillery

Tequilas del Señor was founded in 1943 by Don Cesar Garcia who passed it on to his son Manuel Garcia Villegas to carry out the business. Tequilas del Señor is one of the biggest tequila producers in Mexico, though they don't come close to the volumes that José Cuervo and Sauza produce.
